

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE REMOVAL OF THE UNCONTROLLED MARKED CROSSWALK AT EAST ROMIE LANE AND ALAMEDA AVENUE.

WHEREAS, at its March 3, 2018 meeting, the City Council approved the Salinas Crosswalk Policy that serves as a guideline to provide a uniform application of crosswalks throughout the City (Resolution 20711); and

WHEREAS, at its November 8, 2018 meeting, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (7-0) to recommend to Council to approve the removal of the uncontrolled marked crosswalk at East Romie Lane and Alameda Ave; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the removal of the uncontrolled marked crosswalk at East Romie Lane and Alameda Ave is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the removal of the uncontrolled marked crosswalk at East Romie Lane and Alameda Ave; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City staff is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with the removal of the marked crosswalk to fully effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
