## RESOLUTION NO. 22601 (N.C.S.)

## A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE VICTOR STREET NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING PLAN SUPPORTED BY RESIDENTS

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted the City's Traffic Calming Policy at its October 6, 2009, meeting (Resolution No. 19764) which outlined a process for consideration of traffic calming requests from the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted a resolution approving the prioritization strategy for Traffic Calming requests on its November 7, 2017 meeting (Resolution No. 21291) with the support of the Traffic and Transportation Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, at its June 21, 2022, meeting, City Council approved the 2022-2023 fiscal year priority traffic calming project, whereas Victor Street ranked the fourth highest priority; and

**WHEREAS**, staff worked with residents of Victor Street to develop a traffic calming plan and distribute ballots to help determine neighborhood support of the plan. As required by the City's policy, a vote was conducted to gauge community support, and the Victor Street traffic calming plan received the support votes required as prescribed by the City's Traffic Calming Policy; and

**WHEREAS**, the Traffic and Transportation Commission at its February 9, 2023, meeting voted unanimously (5-1) to recommend the approval of the Victor Street neighborhood traffic calming plan supported by residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the traffic calming plan is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council approves the Victor Street Neighborhood Traffic Calming Plan supported by residents.
