**A RESOLUTION DECLARING CITY VEHICLES AND EQUIPMENT  
SURPLUS AND AUTHORIZING THEIR DISPOSAL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas needs to dispose of surplus vehicles and equipment no longer suitable for City use; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council has the authority to declare City property and equipment surplus and to authorize the disposal of such property and equipment pursuant to Section 12-15 of the Salinas Municipal Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the Finance Director or designee authorize the Ford F-150 CNG truck Vin # 1FTPF17M1YKA91419 to be donated to the Downtown Streets Team with the transfer of title and all other responsibilities; and

**WHEREAS**, utilizing auction companies is more efficient than the traditional method of annual public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, Vehicle Maintenance and Purchasing will determine best course of action for disposal through contracted auction companies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Salinas City Council that pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code section 12-15 the City Council declares the items on the Surplus Vehicles and Equipment list attached to this Resolution as surplus and authorizes their disposal through auction companies by the Purchasing Officer and Vehicle Maintenance staff; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Salinas City Council that pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code section 12-16 the City Council finds that the donation of one of the Surplus Vehicles identified in the attached list (a Ford F-150 CNG Truck VIN # 1FTPF17M1YKA91419) to the Downtown Streets Team will support neighborhood revitalization and further finds that the public convenience, necessity, and welfare and objectives of the City's neighborhood revitalization efforts (including the Chinatown Revitalization Plan and the Downtown Vibrancy Plan) will benefit from the donation of this vehicle to the Downtown Streets Team.
