**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING 130 FEET OF
“NO PARKING” RED ZONES AT THE INTERSECTION OF PARK STREET AND
WEST STREET**

WHEREAS, the City received a request to evaluate the intersection of Park Street and West Street; and

WHEREAS, City Staff has reviewed the intersection and recommends establishing a total of 130 feet of “No Parking” red zone along West Street to improve stopping sight distance at the intersection; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2020, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted (5-2) to recommend to City Council to approve a resolution to establish a total of 130 feet of “No Parking” red zones at the intersection of Park Street and West Street (see Attachment 2); and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the establishment of 130 feet of “No Parking” red zones at the intersection of Park Street and West Street; and
