**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALINAS, CALIFORNIA,
DECLARING THE CANVASS OF RETURNS AND RESULTS OF THE CONSOLIDATED
GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON NOVEMBER 6, 2018 FOR THE OFFICE
OF MAYOR, COUNCIL DISTRICT 2, 3 AND 5**

WHEREAS, on May 15, 2018, the Salinas City Council adopted Resolution No. 21385 duly calling and ordering the November 6, 2018 Consolidated General Municipal Election pursuant to Salinas City Charter Article 3 to fill the office of Mayor for a two-year term and City Councilmembers for District 2, District 3, and District 5 for a four-year term; and

WHEREAS, said municipal election was held on said date in accordance to all applicable provisions of the California Elections Code of the State of California and the City of Salinas Charter, the Registrar of Voters of the County of Monterey has duly canvassed the votes cast by the electors in the City of Salinas upon the offices hereinafter set forth, and has supplied the City Council the certification of the results of the canvass and the final results of the votes cast which are attached as Exhibit A and declared in all respects; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Salinas City Council hereby declare, determine, and order that the number of votes cast for each candidate is as follows:

Joe Gunter received the highest number of votes cast for Salinas Mayor and is hereby elected to said office until the term ending upon declaration of the results of the November 2020 election.

Tony Barrera received the highest number of votes cast for Salinas City Councilmember for District 2 and is hereby elected to said office until the term ending upon declaration of the results of the November 2022 election.

Stephen R. McShane received the highest number of votes cast for Salinas City Councilmember for District 3 and is hereby elected to said office until the term ending upon declaration of the results of the November 2022 election.

Christie Cromeenes received the highest number of votes cast for Salinas City Councilmember for District 5 and is hereby elected to said office until the term ending upon declaration of the results of the November 2022 election.

The "Certificate of the Registrar of Voters for the City of Salinas Election" held on November 6, 2018 is attached as Exhibit A and is incorporated by reference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Clerk is hereby authorized to issue a certificate of election to Joe Gunter, Tony Barrera, Stephen R. McShane, and Christie Cromeenes. The oath of office shall be administered pursuant to the Constitution of the State of California to the elected officers named herein and pursuant to California Government Code section 36503 and California Election Code section 10263(b).
