Executive Summary

The City Council's approval is needed to process the annual levy of assessments within the city's six lighting and landscaping districts Fiscal Year 2025/26 in compliance with the procedures of CA Streets and Highways Code Sections 22620-22641.

Background

The City has established six Landscape Maintenance Assessment Districts (the "LMADs"), governed by Article II, Chapter 21C of the City of Salinas Municipal Code and the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972. The LMADs fund the following.
