**CITY-WIDE PARKING ENFORCEMENT AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS**, On October 13, the City issued a call for proposals seeking innovative, city-wide parking enforcement solutions designed to improve efficiency, enhance customer service, and support the City’s long-term mobility goals, resulting in submissions from two qualified firms; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff conducted a comprehensive review of both proposals submitted by 4-Leaf, Inc. and LAZ Parking California, LLC, evaluating not only completeness and cost efficiency, but also each firm’s ability to leverage technology, streamline operations, and support continuous service improvements; and

**WHEREAS**, LAZ Parking California, LLC demonstrated the strongest combination of cost effectiveness, proven performance, and capacity to implement enhanced, technology-driven enforcement practices, and – having successfully provided these services under the current contract agreement – can ensure uninterrupted service with no transition period; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff selected LAZ Parking California, LLC as the best positioned vendor to partner with the City in advancing modernized, responsive, and future-oriented parking enforcement services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute a services agreement with LAZ Parking California, LLC for City-Wide Parking Enforcement Services for a term of three (3) years with an option to extend for two (2) additional one-year periods, at an annual not-to-exceed amount of \$649,725.
