## RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SALINAS AUTHORIZING SUBRECIPIENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SALINAS AND DOWNTOWN STREETS, INC.

**WHEREAS**, the City relies on collaborative partnerships to address the complex issue of homelessness through subrecipient funding agreements with nonprofit organizations with various program models; and

**WHEREAS,** DSI submitted a proposal to continue its work experience program for FY 2025-2026 in the amount of \$663,000 and

**WHEREAS,** funding for this agreement in an amount not to exceed \$633,000 is included in the FY 2025-26 Operational Budget adopted by City Council on June 17, 2025 (Resolution 23269); and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Salinas has determined that the proposed action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378). In addition, CEQA Guidelines Section 15061 includes the general rule that CEQA applies only to activities which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute Subrecipient Agreement No. 25GF01 with Downtown Streets, Inc. for the work experience Program with street outreach services with a total compensation amount not to exceed \$663,000 from General Funds for FY 2025-26.
