A RESOLUTION FOR EXECUTION OF CONTRACT TO REVISE AND RESTATE TWO (2) JOB ORDER CONTRACTING CLASS A CONTRACT AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF SALINAS AND GRANITE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF SALINAS AND GRANITE ROCK COMPANY (CONTRACT No. 2015-JOB01-CLASS-A)

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2016. the City Council pursuant to Resolution No. 20916 (N.C.S.) approved a resolution for bid award and execution of contract to Granite Construction Company and Granite Rock Company for the Job Order Contracting (JOC) for Miscellaneous Street Maintenance Work. Contract No. 2015-JOB01-Class-A for a base term of one (1) year, with two (2) one-year renewal options; and

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2017, the City Council pursuant to Resolution No. 21203 (N.C.S.) approved a resolution for execution of a 2-year contract to Granite Construction Company and Granite Rock Company for the Job Order Contracting for Miscellaneous Street Maintenance Work, Contract No. 2015-JOB01-Class-A; authorizing the Public Works Director, in consultation with the City Attorney, to execute any amendments to contract and to execute job order contracts plans and specifications for the Job Order Contracting (JOC) for Miscellaneous Street Maintenance Work, Contract No. 2015-JOB01-Class-A; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to increase the maximum contract value of each contract to a not-guaranteed aggregate of four million dollars (\$4 Million); and

WHEREAS, the project will have on-going construction Job Work Orders for the remainder of the contracts, and amendments may need to be made; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the proposed First Revised and Restates Agreements with Granite Construction Company and Granite Rock Company related to the JOC for Miscellaneous Street Maintenance Work, Contract No. 2015-JOB01-Class-A; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council on behalf of the City of Salinas, delegates to the City of Salinas Public Works Director in consultation with the City Attorney, the authority to execute contracts for individual Job Work Orders, and any amendments to the contracts consistent with the proposals of the said successful bidder for said work.
