**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVING ITS HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM-AMERICAN RESCUE  
PLAN ALLOCATION PLAN AND AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL TO THE UNITED STATES  
DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), provides the City of Salinas (City) with a federal entitlement of HOME funds to finance the preservation and production of affordable housing; and

**WHEREAS**, the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021, awarded the City an allocation of \$2,918,774 in HOME American Rescue Plan (HOME-ARP) grant funds to address the need of qualifying populations for housing and supportive services; and

**WHEREAS**, as a requirement of receiving HOME-ARP funds, the City is required to develop a HOME-ARP Allocation Plan comprised of a summary of the consultation and public participation process, a needs assessment and gap analysis, a summary of the planned use of the funds, and an estimate of the number of housing units the City will produce or preserve with the funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the City, through targeted, robust community engagement and the solicitation of input and data, has prepared a HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan proposes to allocate funds towards supportive services as further described and defined in the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan, a draft of the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan, a 30-day invitation for public comment, and notice of a required public hearing were published on September 3, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council held a public hearing on October 4, 2022, to obtain further comment and consider the draft HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City was initially allocated \$145,939 for the administration and planning of the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City will receive its remaining allocation \$2,480,958 in HOME-ARP funds, and an additional \$291,877 for administration and planning of the HOME-ARP award; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to allocate \$437,816 of its HOME-ARP allocation towards program planning and administration and \$2,480,958 toward the provision of supportive services for all qualifying populations as defined by HUD Notice: CPD-21-10; and

**WHEREAS**, the Salinas City Council desires to approve the proposed HOME-ARP Allocation Plan and authorize its submission to HUD for review and approval.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Salinas that it hereby approves the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan as prepared and authorizes its submission to HUD for final review and approval.
