- Human Resources - \$82,328 (44%)*
- Finance - \$294,482 (46%)*
- Community Development - \$601,040 (25%)*
- Police - \$3,023,712 (49%)*
- Fire - \$832,094 (45%)*
- Public Works - \$2,454,790 (48%)*
- Recreation - \$2,059,809 (53%)*
