**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL  
APPROVING THE 2021 CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY  
DEVELOPMENT EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANTS PROGRAM CONTINUUM OF  
CARE ALLOCATION NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY APPLICATION SUBMITTAL**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas (City) is the only City within Monterey and San Benito Counties that administers the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program Continuum of Care (CoC) Allocation; and

**WHEREAS**, HCD approved the City on February 14, 2020 to be the Administrative Entity (AE) for a period of two program years (2020 and 2021) on behalf of the local Salinas/Monterey/San Benito Counties CoC #506 for the HCD ESG Program; and

**WHEREAS**, HCD issued a 2021 ESG CoC Allocation Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) on August 17, 2021 which included a funding formula allocation to the local Salinas/Monterey/San Benito Counties CoC #506 in the amount of \$258,964; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2021 HCD ESG CoC Allocation NOFA application submittal deadline is October 19, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the City intends to submit a 2021 HCD ESG CoC Allocation NOFA application in order to secure funding by no later than the application deadline of October 19,2021; and

**WHEREAS**, should HCD increase the initial 2021 ESG CoC Allocation funding amount to the local Salinas/Monterey/San Benito Counties CoC #506, the City is hereby authorized and directed to receive an ESG grant, not to exceed \$600,000 in accordance with all HCD rules and laws; and

**WHEREAS**, the City hereby agrees to use the ESG funds for eligible activities as approved by HCD and in accordance with all grant program requirements, and other rules and laws, as well as in a manner consistent and in compliance with the Standard Agreement and any other contracts between the City and HCD.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Manager or Community Development Director, is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the City, to submit the 2021 HCD ESG CoC Allocation NOFA application, execute the Standard Agreement and any subsequent amendments or modifications thereto, as well as any other documents which are related to the 2021 HCD ESG CoC Allocation grant program, as HCD may deem appropriate.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Salinas City Council that the City Manager, or Community Development Director, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City of Salinas, City Funding Agreements/Contracts and related documents (e.g., environmental documentation, request for release of funds) in order to implement the 2021 HCD ESG CoC Allocation grant program.
