**A RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE FIRST RESPONDER COST RECOVERY FEE PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS**, on July 11, 2018 the city manager, with city council approval, signed the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement with Monterey County; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 12 of the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement stipulates that the City of Salinas shall not bill for ALS services for the duration of the agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, to ensure compliance with newly executed agreement, staff has directed the third party biller to cease billing practices for emergency medical responses; and

**WHEREAS**, rescinding the First Responder Cost Recovery Fee Program is necessary to maintain compliance with Section 12 of the current Paramedic Service Provider Agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council:

Rescinds Resolution no. 21399 – Which established the City of Salinas First Responder Cost Recovery Fee Program.
