A RESOLUTION RESCINDING THE FIRST RESPONDER COST RECOVERY FEE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2018 the city manager, with city council approval, signed the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement with Monterey County; and

WHEREAS, Section 12 of the Paramedic Service Provider Agreement stipulates that the City of Salinas shall not bill for ALS services for the duration of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, to ensure compliance with newly executed agreement, staff has directed the third party biller to cease billing practices for emergency medical responses; and

WHEREAS, rescinding the First Responder Cost Recovery Fee Program is necessary to maintain compliance with Section 12 of the current Paramedic Service Provider Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council:

Rescinds Resolution no. 21399 – Which established the City of Salinas First Responder Cost Recovery Fee Program.
