**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING 55 FEET OF
“NO PARKING” RED ZONE(S) AT THE INTERSECTION OF ARCHER STREET AND
WEST STREET**

WHEREAS, the City received a request to evaluate corner sight distance at the intersection of Archer Street and West Street to determine proper sightlines necessary to provide stopping sight distance; and

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2019, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (4-0) to recommend to City Council the approval of establishing a total of 55 feet of “No Parking” red zone(s) at the intersection of Archer Street and West Street (see Attachment 2); and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the establishment of 55 feet of “No Parking” Red Zone(s) at the intersection of Archer Street and West Street; and
