

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL GRANT FOR THE CANNABIS TAX FUND GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, increased traffic enforcement is a priority for the City of Salinas, and driving under the influence remains the leading primary crash factor; and

WHEREAS, the Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program (CTFGP) was created following the passage of Proposition 64 in 2016 and directs a portion of State cannabis tax revenues to annual competitive grants administered by the California Highway Patrol (CHP) for impaired-driving reduction activities; and

WHEREAS, the Salinas Police Department has been notified of an award up \$390,484 to fund DUI saturation patrols and purchase equipment necessary for impaired-driving enforcement for the grant period from July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the following:

1. Acceptance of the up to \$390,484 for the California Highway Patrol (CHP) Cannabis Tax Fund Grant Program (CTFGP) Grant; and
2. Delegating authority to the City Manager to execute all necessary documents to effectuate the grant by City Manager; and
3. Establishment of the CHP CTFGP Grant expense appropriation of up to \$390,484 and corresponding revenue budget to support grant activities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the City Manager and Purchasing Agent, upon approval of the City Attorney, to complete any purchases identified in the Grant Award Notification and/or Grant Agreement and to take whatever further action may be necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
