

RESOLUTION NO. 23119 (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A \$338,399 GRANT FOR THE BRIDGE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM FROM THE FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND REAFFIRMING RESOLUTION 17926, AUTHORIZING THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (CALTRANS) RELATED TO THE BRIDGE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PLAN GRANT

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2017, City Council approved Resolution No. 21133 accepting \$40,000 grant from Caltrans to write the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Plan (BPMP) for the City bridges. The BPMP was submitted to Caltrans for funding for Preliminary Engineering and Construction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas was notified by the State Department of Transportation (Caltrans) that Federal Transportation Improvement Program (FTIP) funding would be awarded to the city for preliminary engineering of Project No. BPMPL-5045(046), in the amount of \$336,399; and

WHEREAS, the grant funding requires a 20% local match by the City in the amount of \$84,100; and

WHEREAS, this grant program requires a recent Council Resolution stating the title of the person authorized to enter into a contract with Caltrans and the project title for this grant; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 17926, dated June 4, 2002, authorized the Public Works Director to execute agreements with the State Department of Transportation (Caltrans) related to Council approved grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council approves accepting a \$336,399 grant for City Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program from the Federal Transportation Improvement Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council approves reaffirming Resolution 17926, authorizing the Public Works Director to execute agreements with the Department of Transportation (Caltrans) related to the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Plan Grant awarded to and accepted by the City Council and to take whatever additional action is necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
