**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING A TOTAL OF  
250 FEET OF “NO PARKING” RED ZONE(S) ALONG CARIBBEAN AVENUE,  
PACIFIC AVENUE AND BERMUDA WAY**

**WHEREAS**, the City received a request to evaluate corner sight distance at the intersections of Caribbean Avenue at Tahiti Place, Caribbean Ave at Pacific Avenue and Bermuda Way at Pacific Avenue to determine proper sightlines necessary to provide stopping sight distance; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 13, 2018, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (5-0) to recommend to City Council the approval of establishing a total of 250 feet of “No Parking” red zones at the intersections of Caribbean Avenue at Tahiti Place, Caribbean Ave at Pacific Avenue and Bermuda Way at Pacific Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council hereby approved the establishment of 250 feet of “No Parking” red zones at the intersections of Caribbean Avenue at Tahiti Place, Caribbean Ave at Pacific Avenue and Bermuda Way at Pacific Avenue; and
