

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF THE 2022
LEMHWA GRANT AND EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT WITH LEXIPOL**

WHEREAS, the Salinas Police Department (SPD) has been awarded the 2022 FY22 LEMHWA Grant from the Department of Justice's Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS Office) in the amount of \$124,960.00 to implement mental health and wellness activities for law enforcement personnel; and

WHEREAS, the grant will fund the development and implementation of a mobile Wellness App for law enforcement personnel and the Salinas Police Department selected Lexipol as the vendor for this project; and

WHEREAS, the Salinas Police Department is requesting the execution of an Agreement with Lexipol for the development and implementation of the CordicoShield Law Enforcement Wellness App.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the acceptance of grant funding in the amount of \$124,960.00 from the Department of Justice's Office of Community Oriented Policing Services and further authorizes the execution of all grant acceptance documents; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the establishment of the LEMHWA appropriation of up to \$124,960.00 and corresponding revenue budget for LEMH Grant activities; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the execution of an Agreement with Lexipol for \$37,500.00 for the CordicoShield Law Enforcement Wellness App.
