The BASIS OF AWARD shall be the lowest combined total of the BASE BID as noted on the Proposal. The City reserves the right to award or reject the Base Bid or any item(s) within, depending on available funding.

ANCILLARY ITEMS

Payment for any items that do not have instruction indicating where expenses for said items are to be accounted for are to be considered ancillary to the work and accounted for in every one of the lump sum or unit price items and no additional compensation will be allowed therefore.

These items include, but are not limited to: clean up, complying with permits, expenses relating to obtaining and maintaining bonds, estimating costs, staging areas, compaction, temporary site utilities, caution tape, and similar items.

BID CLARIFICATION

Failure to comply with these requirements may result in the forfeiture of the Bidder’s rank in the Bid process.

In lieu of conflicting portions of "Section 2-1.05 Proposal Forms" of the Standard Specifications, the following shall apply:

Only Bids composed of the above listed items shall be considered for Award. Any and all Addenda to the Plans and Specifications shall be issued electronically on-line through the PlanetBids Vendor Portal website and ONLY to Bidders who are registered Prospective Bidders for this project on-line at the PlanetBids Vendor Portal website as having received a set of Plans and Specifications. The City shall not be responsible for issuance of said Addenda to non-registered Plan holders.

In case of discrepancy between the item price and the total set forth for a unit basis item, the item price shall prevail, provided, however, if the amount set forth as an item price is ambiguous, unintelligible or uncertain for any cause, is omitted, or is the same amount as the entry in the "Total" column, then the amount set forth in the "Total" column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item, and the price thus obtained shall be the item price.

The City reserves the right to award the project to the responsible, responsive Bidder with the lowest possible Bid. The basis of award shall be the lowest total Bid, as noted on the Proposal. This does not preclude the City from adding to or deleting from the contract, any of the bid items and/or any of the BID alternative items after the lowest responsible bidder had been determined. The City further reserves the right to award or reject the Base Bid or any item(s) within, depending on available funding.

Contractor shall provide a schedule of value for all lump sum items of work listed in the Proposal and noted in the Special Provisions. The schedule of values shall be submitted to the City Engineer for approval within 15 calendar days after the Contract has been approved.

All BID ALTERNATE lump sum items shall be all inclusive of but not limited to bond, insurance, contractor overhead and profit, etc.

All costs associated with obtaining the bonds and insurance required by this contract shall be included in the Unit Prices for work items.

Except as may otherwise be provided herein, all work to be done under this Contract shall conform to the applicable requirements of the DESIGN STANDARDS, STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARD PLANS, 2008 Edition, Rev 3, 2017 and updates, City of Salinas Public Works Department, herein referred to as the “Standard Specifications”.

In addition to the Subcontractors required to be listed in conformance with the Standard Specifications, **the Contractor shall submit: name, address, DIR Public Works Registrations number, Contractor’s license number including State/expiration date and the portion of the work that shall be done by each Subcontractor.** All prospective Contractors may use the website <https://www2.cslb.ca.gov/OnlineServices/CheckLicenseII/CheckLicense.aspx> to check each Subcontractor’s license status and the DIR’s Contractor Registration searchable database <https://services.dir.ca.gov/gsp> to verify each Subcontractor’s registration status.

The successful Bidder and all Subcontractors must have a valid City of Salinas business license before the commencement of work.

The compensation payable for asphalt concrete shall be increased or decreased in conformance with the Provisions of Section 5-1.07, “Compensation Adjustments for Price Index Fluctuations for Asphalt Concrete” within these Special Provisions. The website for the Paving Asphalt Price Index is at http://www.dot.ca.gov/hq/esc/oe/asphalt_index/astable.html.

All prospective Bidders shall use Caltrans’ DBE listing which is available on the website address <https://caltrans.dbesystem.com/>

Also, the award of the Contract, if it be awarded, shall be to the lowest responsible Bidder whose Proposal complies with all the requirements prescribed and who has met the goal for DBE participation or has demonstrated, to the satisfaction of the City of Salinas, adequate good faith efforts to do so. Meeting the goal for DBE participation or demonstrating to the satisfaction of the City of Salinas, adequate good faith efforts to do so is a condition for being eligible for award of Contract.

The undersigned understands that the quantities given are approximate only, being given as a basis for the comparison of Bids, and the City of Salinas does not, expressly or by implication, agree that the actual amount of work shall correspond therewith, but reserves the right to increase or decrease the amount of any portion of the work or to omit portions of the work as may be deemed necessary or advisable by the City Engineer without claim for damage or loss of anticipated profit and that payment shall be made only on the basis of the actual quantities of work performed.

CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE AND WORKING DAYS

The Contractor shall diligently prosecute the on-site work to completion on or before the expiration of 120 on-site WORKING DAYS commencing January 13, 2025.

The Contractor shall begin the off-site work within Fifteen (15) calendar days after the Notice to Proceed by the City Engineer. No work shall commence before approval of Baseline Schedule. The allotted Calendar Days between award of contract and the commencement of on-site working days shall be reserved for off-site work including material submittals and the ordering and receiving of materials, after said notification. Access to the fire station will be provided by the city to the contractor for field verification of existing conditions. All on-site access to be coordinated with the fire department to ensure there is no impact on emergency response. Any destructive testing/access shall be approved by the fire department prior to the commencement of work.

PROPOSAL – cont.

The undersigned further agrees that all work to be done under this Contract shall be done in accordance with the provisions of that certain form of Agreement attached hereto and hereby made a part of these Specifications.

The undersigned agrees, if awarded the Contract, that there shall be paid by the undersigned and by all Subcontractors under him/her, to all laborers, workmen and mechanics employed in the execution of such Contract or any Subcontract thereunder, not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and rates for overtime and legal holidays in the locality in which the work is to be performed, as ascertained and determined, pursuant to the state statute thereto applicable, by the City Council, the schedule thereof being set forth in the advertisement for Bids and in the Specifications for said work.

Enclosed herein is a (Bidder's bond, certified check, or cashier check) for not less than **10%** of the total amount of the Proposal and the undersigned agrees that, in case of his/her default in executing the Contract and the necessary bonds after award and due notice thereof, the said check or bond and the money payable thereon shall become and remain the property of the City of Salinas as liquidated damages.
