WHEREAS, on November 1, 2017, the City of Salinas and Smith & Enright formally extended the term of the Agreement through November 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, on November 1, 2019, the City of Salinas and Smith & Enright formally extended the term of the Agreement through November 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on October 12, 2021, the City of Salinas and Smith & Enright formally extended the term of the Agreement through November 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas approve an increase of \$95,000 to the annual not to exceed amount to the Original Agreement for a total of \$345,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves an amendment to the services agreement between the City of Salinas and Smith & Enright Landscaping, Inc. to increase by \$95,000 for a total not to exceed annual amount of \$345,000 for continued unlawful campsite cleanups; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Interim City Manager is authorized to execute the amendment on behalf of the City.
