A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE CURTIS STREET NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CALMING PLAN

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted the City’s Traffic Calming Policy at its October 6, 2009 meeting (Resolution No. 19764) which outlined a process for consideration of traffic calming requests from the community; and

WHEREAS, following the process set by said policy, staff worked with residents at the affected neighborhood, to develop a traffic calming plan and determine support for said plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that implementing the traffic calming plan is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALINAS that the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Plan for the Curtis Street neighborhood proposed through this Resolution is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that City staff is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with implementation to fully effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
