RESOLUTION NOS. 22353, 22295, 22200, 22311, 22201 RELATED

TO THE DIRECT PURCHASE OF CITY VEHICLES

RECOMMENDED MOTION:

It is recommended that City Council

- 1. Approve a price increase of up to twenty five percent to each of the vehicles included in previously approved resolutions (Resolution Nos. 22353, 22295, 22200, 22201, and 22311) and also authorize such purchases to be made from any suitable vendor, including the currently approved vendor based on price and availability; and
- 2. Amend the purchases previously approved in Resolution 22200 to a 2023 model year at a new total cost of \$55,834.82.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that City Council approve a price increase of up to twenty five percent to each of the vehicles included in previously approved resolutions (Resolution Nos. 22353, 22295, 22200, 22201, and 22311) and also authorize such purchases to be made from any suitable vendor, including the currently approved vendor based on price and availability; and amend the purchase previously approved in Resolution 22200 to a 2023 model year at a new total cost of \$55,834.82.

DISCUSSION:

This report will explain the need to revisit and amend previously approved purchases.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Salinas has been renewing the older fleet to meet maintenance needs. Below is a list of vehicles that have been previously ordered and not received. There has been numerous delays and price increases to these vehicles. The 2021 MY Ford Transit van has been on order since October 2021 and was just cancelled by Ford. The new pricing for a 2023 MY is \$55,834.82. To

keep these orders moving forward we are requesting that there be up to a twenty five percent increase allowance in addition to having flexibility to look at other options to purchase to fulfill our orders.
