AGREEMENT FOR FLEET MANAGEMENT SERVICES

WHEREAS, the city endeavors to consolidate its fleet management services to provide for consistency and economies of scale; and

WHEREAS, Mercury Associates Fleet Management Consulting can provide the expertise to help the City achieve this goal and establish a robust safety program for fleet operations; and

WHEREAS, autonomous fleet operations are inherently inefficient because they reduce duplications of effort; and

WHEREAS, improved service level and reduced costs are expected by consolidating management; and

WHEREAS, not providing a program for fleet management and centralization will be detrimental to City finances and the users of the City Fleet; and

WHEREAS, Mercury Associates can fulfill the duties to implement the new processes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council approves the professional services agreement in the amount of \$169,460 between the City of Salinas and Mercury Associates, Inc. for services related to fleet management, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Salinas City Council approves the transfer of \$54,208.51 from CIP 9525 to CIP 9226 to fund this agreement.
