

RESOLUTION NO. _____ (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2021 the City Council pursuant to Resolution No. (N.C.S.) approved specifications for the Annual Maintenance Districts' Landscape Services; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the City Clerk of Salinas on May 25, 2021, via a Zoom meeting, held at the City Yard Conference Room at 426 Work Street, Salinas, California, publicly opened, and read the results of the bids downloaded through Planebids, examined, and declared the proposals delivered to or filed with said City Clerk for the Harden Ranch Maintenance District Landscape Services; the North/East Maintenance District Landscape Services; the Monte Bella Maintenance District Landscape Services; and the Mira Monte, Airport and Woodside Maintenance Districts' Landscape Service, in accordance with the specifications for such work filed in the office of said City Clerk on June 10, 2021, and now on file in said office; and

WHEREAS, for the Harden Ranch Maintenance District, the lowest bidder, Brightview Landscape Services, Inc. submitted a total annual bid of \$51,933.96 and sufficient funds are available to award the contract; and

WHEREAS, for the North/East Maintenance District, the lowest bidder, Smith & Enright Landscape Company submitted a total annual bid of \$318,480.00 and sufficient funds are available to award the contract; and

WHEREAS, for the Monte Bella Maintenance District, the lowest bidder, Smith & Enright Landscaping Company submitted a total annual bid of \$47,940 and sufficient funds are available to award the contract; and

WHEREAS, for the Mira Monte, Airport and Woodside Maintenance Districts, the lowest bidder, Brightview Landscape Service, Inc. submitted a total annual bid of \$48,579.96 and sufficient funds are available to award the contract; and

WHEREAS, City staff thereupon reported the results of the proposals submitted to the City Council at its regular meeting on June 22, 2021, and the Council in open session at said meeting examined the report of staff; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council that pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code section 12-21, in reference to the Harden Ranch Maintenance District Landscape Services contract, that all of said proposals are rejected except the proposal of Brightview Landscape Service, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "Harden Ranch District's Successful

Bidder”), being the lowest and best bid, which is hereby accepted. The subject contract is hereby awarded to Harden Ranch District’s Successful Bidder for the sum of \$51,933.96 per year (for a period of three years, with an option to extend an additional two years), and more specifically at the unit and extra work prices particularly set forth and contained in the Proposal for Landscape Services for Harden Ranch Maintenance District, previously filed in the office of the City Clerk on June 22, 2021. Said sum shall be paid by the City of Salinas to Harden Ranch District’s Successful Bidder in cash, lawful money of the United States of America, payable at the time and in the manner specified in the specifications and contract documents filed in the office of the City Clerk on June 22, 2021 entitled “Harden Ranch Maintenance District Landscape Services.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council that pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code section 12-21, in reference to the North/East Maintenance District Landscape Services contract, that all of said proposals are rejected except the proposal of Smith & Enright Landscape Company (hereinafter referred to as “North/East District’s Successful Bidder”), having a bid within 5% of the closest bid, and awarded the contract under the local preference definition which is hereby accepted. The subject contract is hereby awarded to North/East District’s Successful Bidder for the sum of \$318,480.00 per year (for a period of three years, with an option to extend an additional Two years), and more specifically at the unit and extra work prices particularly set forth and contained in the Proposal for Landscape Services for the North/East Maintenance District, previously filed in the office of the City Clerk on June 22, 2021. Said sum shall be paid by the City of Salinas to North/East District’s Successful Bidder in cash, lawful money of the United States of America, payable at the time and in the manner specified in the specifications and contract documents filed in the office of the City Clerk on June 22, 2021 entitled “North/East Maintenance District Landscape Services.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council that pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code section 12-21, in reference to the Monte Bella Maintenance District Landscape Services contract, that all of said proposals are rejected except the proposal of Smith & Enright Landscaping (hereinafter referred to as “Monte Bella District’s Successful Bidder”), being the lowest and best bid, which is hereby accepted. The subject contract is hereby awarded to Monte Bella District’s Successful Bidder for the sum of \$47,940.00 per year (for a period of three years, with an option to extend an additional two years), and more specifically at the unit and extra work prices particularly set forth and contained in the Proposal for Landscape Services for the Monte Bella Maintenance District, previously filed in the office of the City Clerk on June 22, 2021. Said sum shall be paid by the City of Salinas to Monte Bella District’s Successful Bidder in cash, lawful money of the United States of America, payable at the time and in the manner specified in the specifications and contract documents filed in the office of the City Clerk on June 22, 2021 entitled “Monte Bella Maintenance District Landscape Services.”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council that pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code section 12-21, in reference to the Mire Monte, Airport and Woodside Maintenance District Landscape Services contract, that all of said proposals are rejected except the proposal of Brightview Landscape Service, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the “Mira Monte, Airport and Woodside Districts’ Successful Bidder”), being the lowest and best bid, which is hereby accepted.

The subject contract is hereby awarded to the Mira Monte, Airport and Woodside Districts' Successful Bidder for the sum of \$48,579.96 per year (for a period of three years, with an option to extend an additional two years), and more specifically at the unit and extra work prices particularly set forth and contained in the Proposal for Landscape Services for the Mira Monte, Airport and Woodside Maintenance Districts, previously filed in the office of the City Clerk on June 22, 2021. Said sum shall be paid by the City of Salinas to the Mira Monte, Airport and Woodside Districts' Successful Bidder in cash, lawful money of the United States of America, payable at the time and in the manner specified in the specifications and contract documents filed in the office of the City Clerk on June 22, 2021 entitled "Mira Monte, Airport and Woodside Maintenance Districts Landscape Services."

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said specifications and contract documents are hereby referred to for all of the details and particulars thereof, and said specifications and contract are by reference incorporated in and hereby made a part of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER ESOLVED that the Mayor of Salinas is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Salinas to execute a contract consistent with the Proposal of Harden Ranch District's Successful Bidder for said work effective the date of this Resolution, and appropriate an additional \$10,534.00 from the District's reserve to pay for the additional expense.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of Salinas is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Salinas to execute a contract consistent with the Proposal of North/East District's Successful Bidder for said work effective the date of this Resolution, and appropriate an additional \$101,064.00 from the District's reserve to pay for the additional expense.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of Salinas is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Salinas to execute a contract consistent with the Proposal of Monte Bella District's Successful Bidder for said work effective the date of this Resolution and appropriate an additional \$7,260.00 from the District's reserve to pay for the additional expense.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of Salinas is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of the City of Salinas to execute a and a contract consistent with the Proposal of Mira Monte, Airport and Woodside Districts' Successful Bidder for said work effective the date of this Resolution.
