

**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (N.C.S.)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE EXTENSION OF OUR EXISTING AGREEMENT WITH CINTAS, INCORPORATED FOR UNIFORM RENTAL AND LAUNDRY SERVICES**

**WHEREAS**, On August 4, 2020, Salinas City Council approved an agreement with Cintas Incorporated (“Cintas”) for Uniform Rental Laundry Services in an amount not to exceed \$53,402; and

**WHEREAS**, On August 26, 2020, Amendment No. 1 was approved adding Salinas Airport personnel to the Agreement, increasing the agreement amount to \$55,902; and

**WHEREAS**, On July 15, 2021, Amendment No. 2 was approved to increase payment terms to account for an increase in the level of expected services, bringing the Agreement total to an amount not to exceed \$61,902; and

**WHEREAS**, On May 16, 2023, Amendment No. 3 was approved to increase the Agreement total not to exceed \$75,152 to cover the costs of increased services for additional employees for the remainder of the agreement ending August 8, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, On July 13, 2023, Cintas requested a one-year extension and City staff accepted the request to extend the current agreement for one-year per the terms of the original signed and approved agreement for a cost not to exceed \$77,652 with a 10% contingency; and

**WHEREAS**, On June 11, 2024, Cintas requested the final one-year extension and City staff accepted the request to extend the current agreement for the final year per the terms of the original signed and approved agreement for a cost not to exceed \$89,750 annually.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council approves an extension of the agreement with Cintas Incorporated to continue services for the final one-year term in an amount not to exceed \$89,750 annually and authorizes the City Manager to enter into the extension on behalf of the City.
