**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING AN ALL WAY STOP AT
THE INTERSECTION OF CAPITOL STREET AND ALISAL STREET**

WHEREAS, traffic analysis conducted by the City indicates that a signal installation at the Alisal Street and Capitol Street intersection meets warrants established by Caltrans; and

WHEREAS, the County Government Campus Development approval recommended that the County contribute to the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection; and

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2016, the City Council approved grant funding for the Downtown Complete Streets Project; and on November 29, 2016 approved the design work for said project that makes improvements along the West Alisal Street corridor which includes improvements at the Alisal-Capitol intersection; and

WHEREAS, Section 2B.07(A) of the California Manual of Traffic Control Devices (Ca-MUTCD) indicates that an All-Way Stop may be considered as an interim measure at an intersection that has met the warrants for a traffic signal;

WHEREAS, current conditions indicate a need for immediate action in placing the all way stop at Capitol and Alisal Street;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALINAS approves the installation of an All-Way stop at the Alisal-Capitol intersection as an interim measure while a signal installation is planned, pursuant to the Ca MUTCD.
