A. FY 25-26 City-Wide Schedule of Fees and Service Charges

Acting Assistant Finance Director Abe Pedroza delivered the annual update on the FY 25-26 City-Wide schedule of fees and service charges, noting the historical increases, outreach to various agencies, and detail by fee group. The committee unanimously moved to recommend a 2.8% CPI increase per the municipal code to the full council on 4/22/25.

B. City Development Impact Fees Annual Adjustment

Assistant Public Works Director Adriana Robles delivered the annual update on the FY 25-26 City Development Impact fees, noting the background, outreach to various agencies, and relevant financials by fund/fee. The committee unanimously moved to recommend a 1.6% ENR increase to the full council on 4/22/25.

C. Sanitary Sewer Rate Study and Rate Schedule

Assistant Public Works Director Adriana Robles presented a follow up to the previous meeting regarding the Sanitary Sewer Study and Rate Schedule. Ms. Robles recapped the sewer system, impacts of funding shortfall, rate study, proposed sewer rates, and additional analysis/findings. The committee unanimously moved to recommend approval of the Sanitary Sewer Rate Study and Rate Schedule to the full council on 4/22/25.
