A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A MUNICIPAL HAZARDOUS MATERIALS RESPONSE SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE SANTA CLARA STADIUM AUTHORITY AND THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA

WHEREAS, The Santa Clara Stadium Authority and the City of Santa Clara desire to contract with the City of Salinas for the provision of supplemental hazardous materials response services during periodic major events at the Santa Clara Stadium site, as outlined in the Municipal Hazardous Materials Response Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, The Agreement formalizes the process by which the Santa Clara Stadium Authority and the City of Santa Clara may request supplemental hazardous materials response services and establishes a clear mechanism for reimbursement of all related costs; and

WHEREAS, The Salinas Fire Department has determined it is able and willing to provide such hazardous materials response services, subject to staffing availability, operational discretion of the Salinas Fire Chief or designee, and the requirement that public safety within the City of Salinas is not adversely impacted; and

WHEREAS, Under the Agreement, the City of Salinas will provide, as available, a Type 1 Hazardous Materials Response Team meeting FIREScope standards, including:

A minimum of eight (8) hazardous materials specialists with WMD certificates;

One (1) Assistant Safety Officer Hazmat; and

One (1) team leader to serve as the Agency representative.

All staffing classifications and personnel numbers will be mutually agreed upon in writing prior to each event; and

WHEREAS, The City of Santa Clara and the Santa Clara Stadium Authority agree to compensate the City of Salinas at the established rates identified in Exhibit A of the Agreement, including hourly rates, travel time, and reimbursement for mileage and expendable or damaged hazardous materials equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the *Municipal Hazardous Materials Response Services* agreement between the City of Salinas, the Santa Clara Stadium Authority, and the City of Santa Clara for the provision of supplemental hazardous materials response services during major events at the Santa Clara Stadium site.
