

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING AN ALL-WAY STOP AT NORTH MADEIRA AVENUE AND ROOSEVELT STREET

WHEREAS, in mid 2023 the City received a request to install All-Way STOP signs at North Madeira Avenue and Roosevelt Street; and

WHEREAS, the California Manual on Traffic Control Devices (CA-MUTCD) establishes quantitative and qualitative criteria for installation for stop signs, including All-Way STOP; and

WHEREAS, Staff conducted a traffic analysis and determined that the intersection of North Madeira Avenue and Roosevelt Street satisfied the qualitative criteria due to its proximity to school bus pickup/drop off, La Paz Park, senior centers and pedestrian crossings for middle and high schools; and

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2026 the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted (5-0) recommending the City Council approve a Resolution establishing an All-Way STOP at the intersection of North Madeira Avenue and Roosevelt Street; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends the approval of an all-way STOP application at the intersection of North Madeira Avenue and Roosevelt Street; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing of an All-Way STOP is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves a Resolution establishing an All-Way STOP at North Madeira Avenue and Roosevelt Street.
