A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECT PURCHASE OF TRAFFIC SIGNAL ADAPTIVE EQUIPMENT

WHEREAS, City traffic impact fees are allocated to Capital Improvement Project 9278 (N. Main Street/Boronda Road Improvements) to upgrade signals for corridor progression; and

WHEREAS, The Traffic Impact Analysis (TIA) for the Northridge Mall Expansion prescribed mitigation measures to maintain an acceptable level of service for traffic along Northridge Mall's North Main Street frontage; and

WHEREAS, Rhythm's InSync traffic adaptive signal system is installed along the N. Main Street corridor from Bernal Street to Alvin Street (5 intersections) and along Boronda Road from Main Street to Independence Boulevard (7 intersections); and

WHEREAS, for compatibility with said system, the Rhythm traffic adaptive video detection system will be required to communicate with existing software/hardware installed at adjacent intersections along North Main Street and Boronda Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL that the Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to direct purchase Rhythm's InSync Traffic Adaptive Video Detection System for a total of \$85,573.34 as specified in the Staff Report and the attachments thereto which accompany this Resolution, using traffic mitigation funding from CIP 9278
