

**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_\_ (N.C.S.)**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ALONG RIKER STREET INTERSECTIONS FOR SIGHTLINE CLEARANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted the implementation of the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Plan for the Riker Street neighborhood at its February 20, 2018 meeting (Resolution No. 21345); and

**WHEREAS**, on August 9, 2018, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted unanimously (6-0) to recommend that Council approve an additional 936 feet of parking restrictions along Riker Street intersections; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the addition of 936 feet of parking restrictions along Riker Street intersections for sight clearance, as shown on Exhibit A, herein incorporated; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that City staff is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with implementation to fully effectuate the intent of this Resolution.
