

# Encampment Resolution Program

Intended to strengthen collaboration between state and local jurisdictions and Continuums of Care (CoCs) to address and ensure the health and safety of individuals experiencing unsheltered homelessness in encampments and transition residents into safe, stable housing

### **Jurisdictional Collaboration**

- City of Salinas
- County of Monterey
- Caltrans

### Key Components of Proposal

- ➤ Rehabilitation of the City-owned EL REY Motel
- ➤ Operational funding for Low Barrier Navigation Center (LBNC) at EL REY Motel
- ➤ Partial operations for Salinas Outreach and Response Team
- ➤ Resolving encampments along the Davis Street Corridor.
- ØCity of Salinas Request: \$2,300,000
  - Capital Improvements \$1,100,000
  - Repairs and Damages \$200,000
  - Salinas Outreach and Response Team (SORT) \$1,000,000

ØTotal Estimated Project Cost: Up to \$8,000,000



### Anticipated Outcomes

- ➤ Provide interim shelter and support services
- Serve approximately 80 individuals currently residing in Davis Street Corridor encampments
- ➤ Offer a low-barrier, non-punitive, and person-centered environment

► Align with Housing First principles
