# Executive Summary

- Approval provides additional SWAT vehicle for the Tactical Medics
- Vehicle has been donated by American Medical Response and is a decommissioned ambulance
- Vehicle will be re-painted and structured for SWAT team use
- Vehicle will serve as an equipment and tactical medic transportation vehicle, not an ambulance
- There is no general fund costs to the city

# Background

- SWAT Tactical Medic Program developed
- Tactical Medic component consists of 3 or 4 tactical medics
- Tactical Medics train and deploy with SWAT team during critical incidents
- Deployed into the “Hot Zone” for immediate critical care of downed officers or community members
- Vehicle would provide rapid response and deployment capabilities
- Multi-agency and County Wide asset

# Discussion

- Mutual agreement between Salinas Police Department and the Salinas Fire Department for acquisition and use
- Agreed upon Salinas PD will acquire and outfit vehicle and Salinas Fire will Maintain and Store the vehicle
- Understood the vehicle will not be used for the transportation of patients by Fire Medics.
- Utilization of the decommissioned ambulance has been approved by Monterey County Emergency Medical Services Agency.
