

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING CALIFORNIA AID TO AIRPORTS PROGRAM (CAAP)
ANNUAL CREDITS FOR ELIGIBLE PROJECTS AT THE SALINAS MUNICIPAL
AIRPORT**

WHEREAS, public-use airports in the State of California, by way of the State Aeronautics Act, through the California Aid to Airports Program (CAAP), receive an annual non-discretionary grant of \$10,000 (annual credit); and

WHEREAS, credits payable under this program are credited to individual airport subaccounts annually and may be accumulated for a maximum period of five years; and

WHEREAS, these funds are paid to public entities upon request for expenditure on preapproved eligible projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has accumulated four years of credits totaling \$40,000 and desires to expend those credits on eligible purchases.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council approves the acceptance and appropriation of \$40,000 to the Airport Enterprise Fund from the State of California, Department of Transportation, California Aid to Airports Program (CAAP) for eligible purchases at the Salinas Municipal Airport; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the City Council authorizes and empowers the Interim City Manager, or designee, and Finance Director to execute on behalf of the City of Salinas all required documentation with respect to the application for and the acceptance of State of California, Department of Transportation, California Aid to Airports Program (CAAP) funding.
