**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING
APPROXIMATELY 1,000 FEET OF 90-MINUTE PARKING ZONE EXCEPT SUNDAY**

WHEREAS, City staff received a request from Ray Harrod, the owner of the newly constructed units along the 400 & 500 block on Abbott Street and Alameda Avenue, to install 90-minute parking zone except Sunday designations along the business' Abbott Street and Alameda Avenue frontage; and

WHEREAS, the 90-minute parking restricted spaces are for public use. The owner has applied for 90-minute parking zones with payment for the cost to install the traffic control devices; and

WHEREAS, the application is consistent with the City's program and therefor staff recommends approving the requested; and

WHEREAS, on July 14, 2022, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted 6-0 to recommend to Council to approve staff's recommendation of approximately 1,000 feet of 90-minute green zones except Sunday designations to allow for a quick turnaround of parking spaces for customers to have access to businesses located along the 400 & 500 block on Abbott Street and Alameda Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves approximately 1,000 feet of 90-minute parking zone except Sunday designations along the 400 & 500 block on Abbott Street and Alameda Avenue.
