

## **SB 2 Planning Grants Program Eligible Activities**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Update to general plans, community plans, specific plans, local planning related to implementation of sustainable communities' strategies, or local coastal plans;</li><li>• Updates to zoning ordinances;</li><li>• Environmental analyses that eliminate the need for project-specific review;</li><li>• Local process improvements that improve and expedite local planning;</li><li>• A smaller geography with a significant impact on housing production including an overlay district, project level specific plan, or development standards modifications proposed for significant areas of locality, such as corridors, downtown or priority growth areas;</li><li>• The creation or enhancement of a housing sustainability district;</li><li>• Workforce housing opportunity zone;</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Zoning by-right supportive housing;</li><li>• Zoning incentives for housing for persons with special needs, including persons with development disabilities;</li><li>• Rezoning to meet requirement pursuant to Government Code Section 65583.2(c) and other rezoning efforts to facilitate supply and affordability;</li><li>• Rezoning for multifamily housing in high resource areas;</li><li>• Pre-approved architectural and site plans;</li><li>• Regional housing trust fund plans;</li><li>• SB 2 funding plans;</li><li>• Infrastructure financing plans;</li><li>• Environmental hazard assessments; data collection on permit tracking; feasibility studies, site analysis; and</li><li>• Other planning activities demonstrating a nexus to accelerating housing production.</li></ul>
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
