
## **GENERAL OVERVIEW**

- ► Initial Presentation of Ordinance to City Council on April 26, 2022
- ► California's Assembly Bill 481 (AB-481)
  - Defines "Military Equipment"
- ► SPD Policy 709, including Equipment List
  - 15 Categories SPD's Inventory (9 out of 15 categories)
- ► Provides Transparency to Public
  - Encourages Public Input and Protects the Public's Welfare, Safety, Civil Rights, and Liberties

## **KEY POINTS**

- Primary Purpose
  - De-escalation, stand-off distance, safety of citizens and officers, preserving human life
- Necessity
  - Equipment obtained determined to be necessary based on real incidents encountered by SPD
- Usage
  - Majority of equipment is utilized exclusively by specialty units; highly trained personnel
