RESOLUTION No. (N.C.S.)

A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL AMENDING FUNDING PARAMETERS FOR THE ALLOCATION OF CDBG PUBLIC SERVICES FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas participates in the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and such grant program allows for the City to allocate up to 15% of each year's available CDBG funds for the provision of needed "public services" within the community; and,

WHEREAS, the Salinas City Council on November 18, 2003 adopted Resolution No. 18402 (N.C.S) establishing a set of written funding parameters for guidance regarding the allocation of CDBG public services funds; and

WHEREAS, the Salinas City Council has previously amended the funding parameters on May 6, 2008 (Resolution No. 1944 N.C.S), on November 18, 2008 (Resolution No. 19562 N.C.S, on May 5, 2009 (Resolution No. 19644 N.C.S), on April 19, 2011 (Resolution No. 19993 N.C.S), on May 3, 2011 (Resolution No. 20001 N.C.S.), on May 8, 2012 (Resolution No. 20188 N.C.S.) and on May 21, 2013 (Resolution No. 20379 N.C.S.); and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Subcommittee of the City Council observed that the wording of Parameter No. 3 could benefit from clarification, namely the provision of "services in the community" could read "services to people in the City of Salinas," which also conforms to HUD regulations about beneficiaries of CDBG programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF SALINAS, that the attached PUBLIC SERVICES FUNDING PARAMETERS – 2014, are hereby established as guidelines for the annual allocation of CDBG funds for public services activities, thereby replacing the previous guidelines from 2013.
