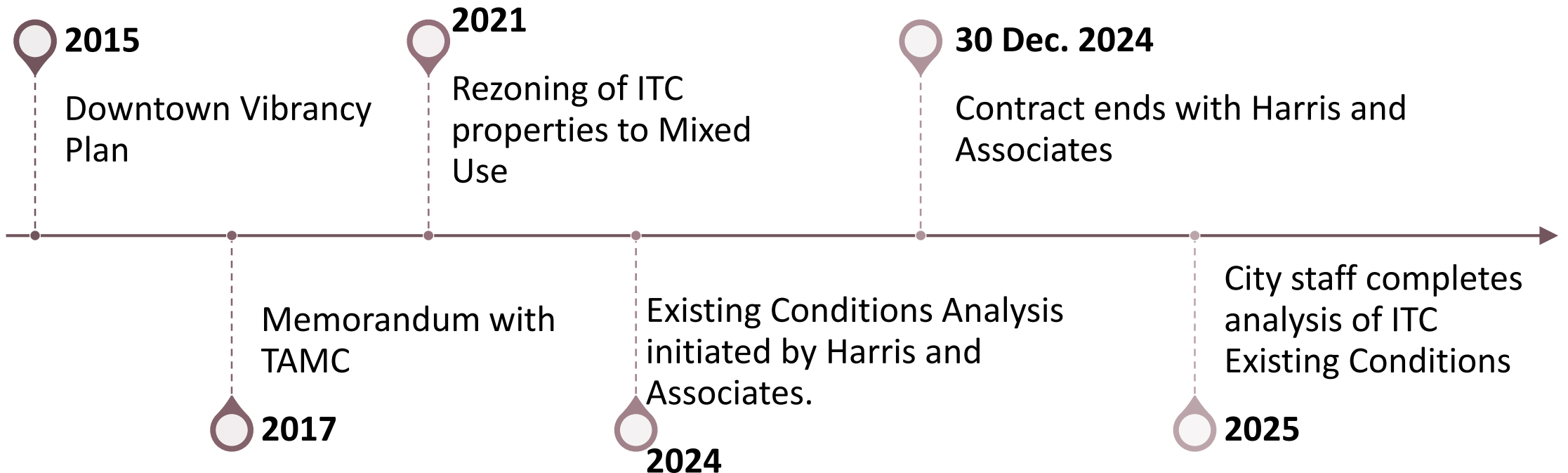

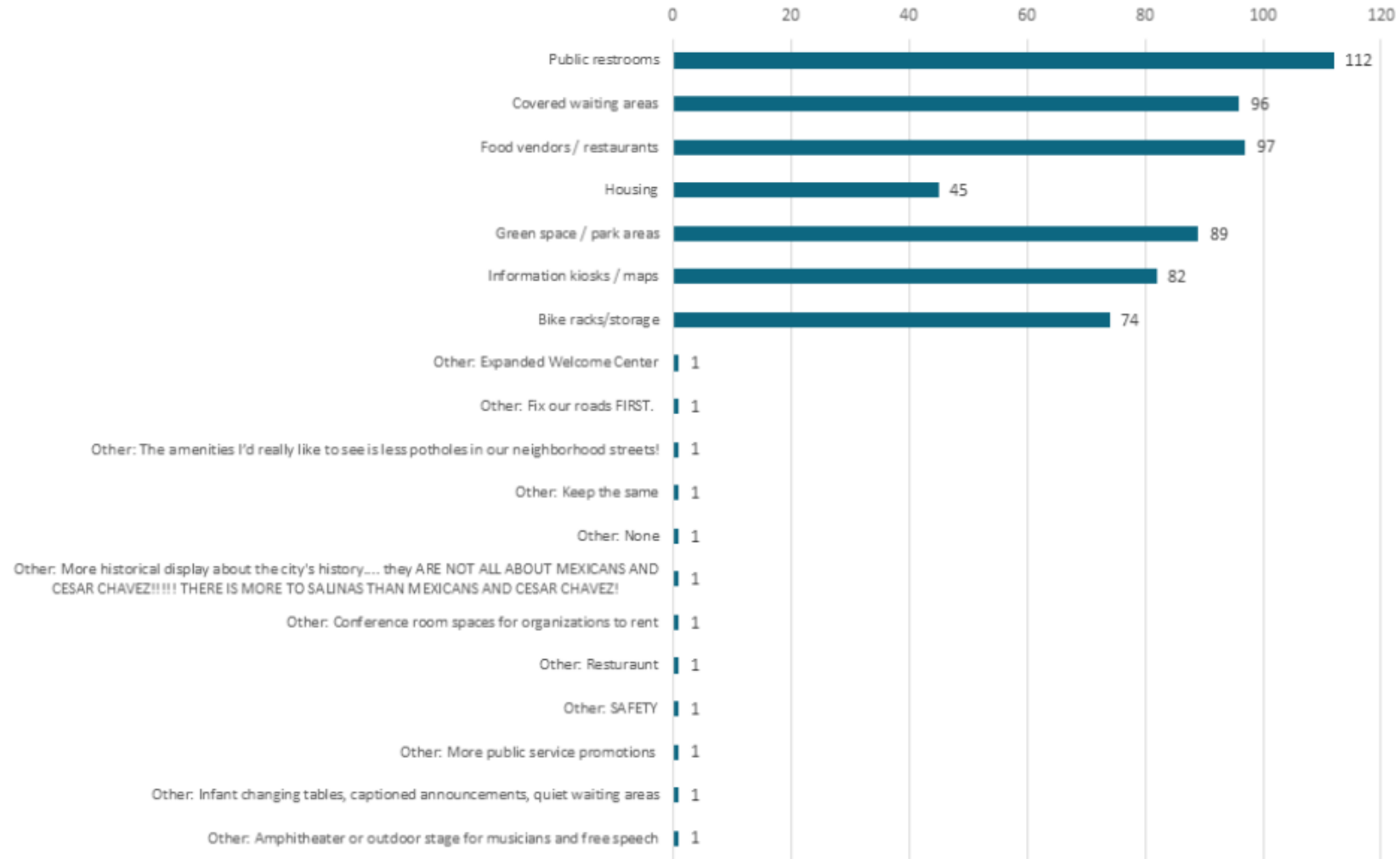

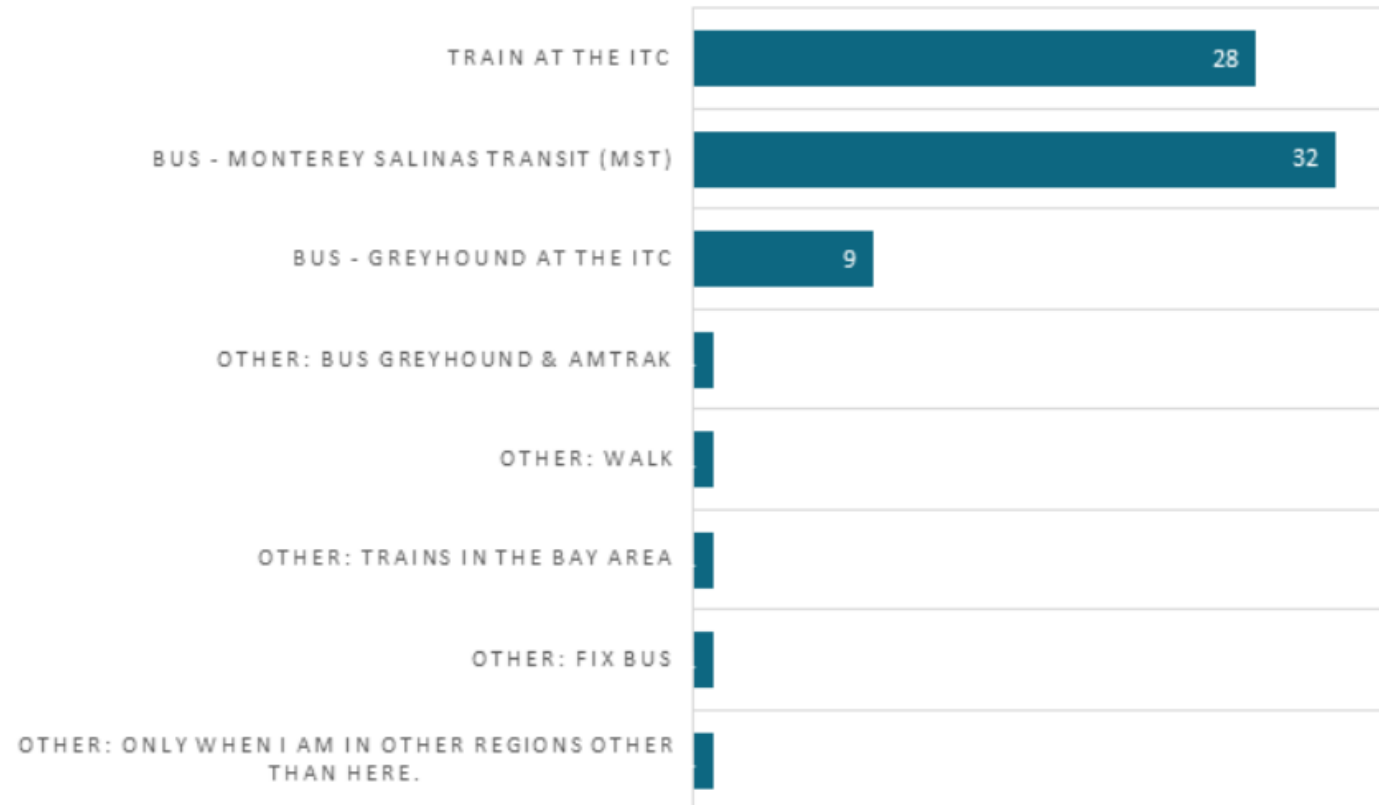
What amenities would you like to see included at the ITC? (check all that apply)

All respondents.

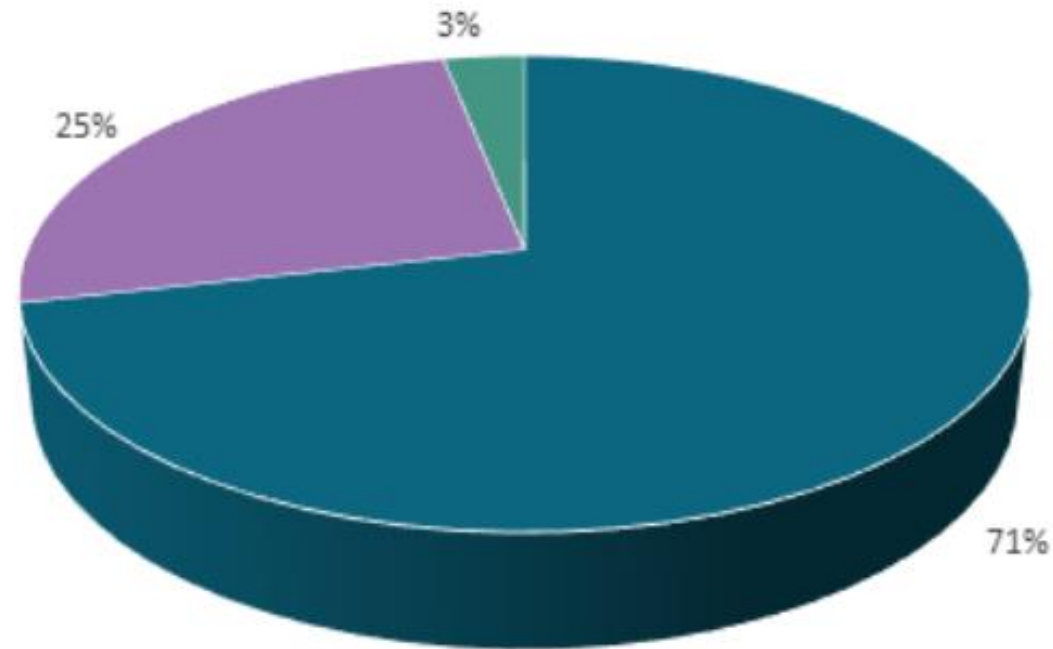


What modes of public transportation do you use? (select all that apply)

MST is currently studying:

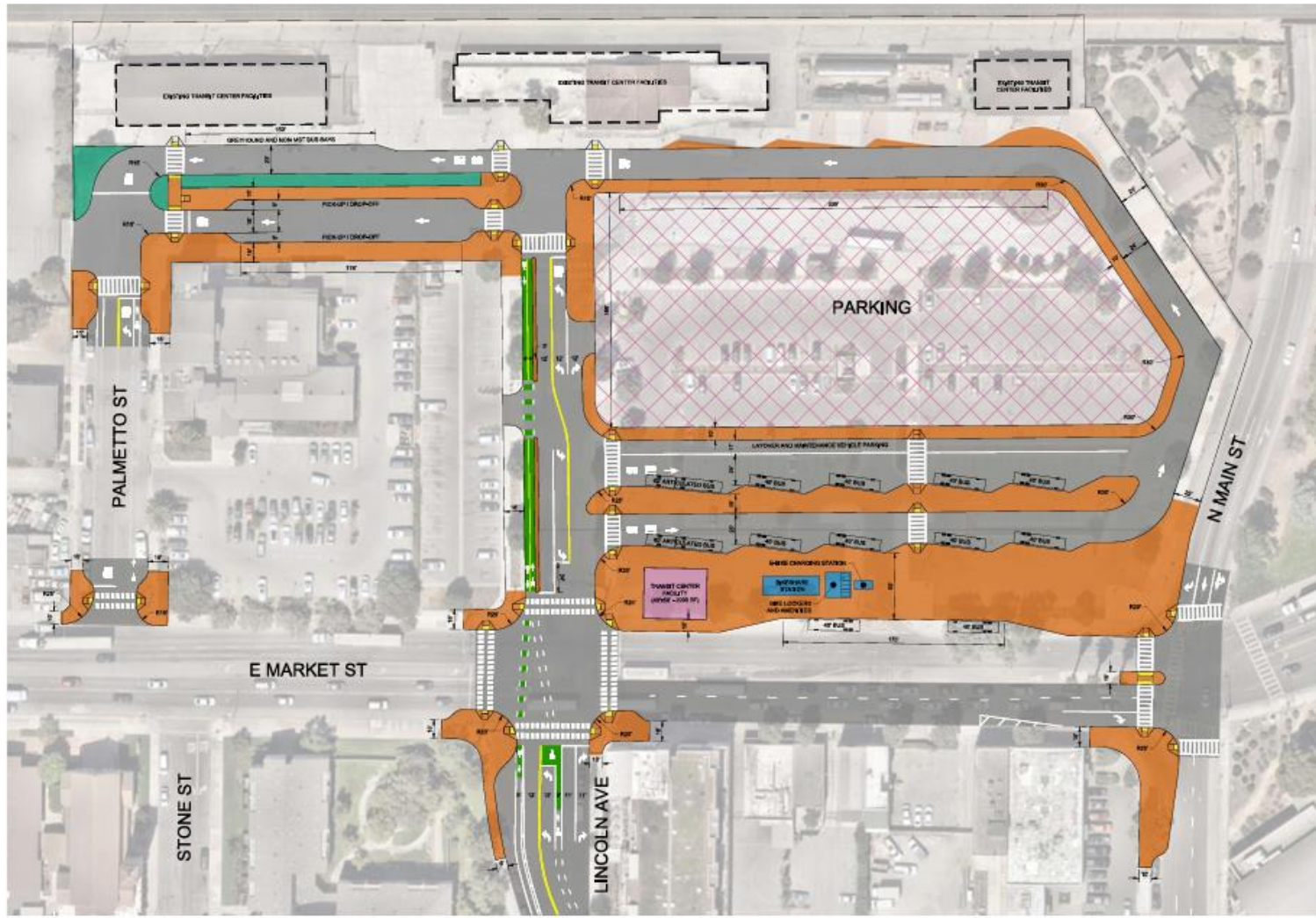
- Improvements along East Alisal St. and Williams Rd.

Potential Connection to the ITC:

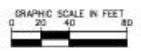
- Opportunity to co-locate local and regional transit

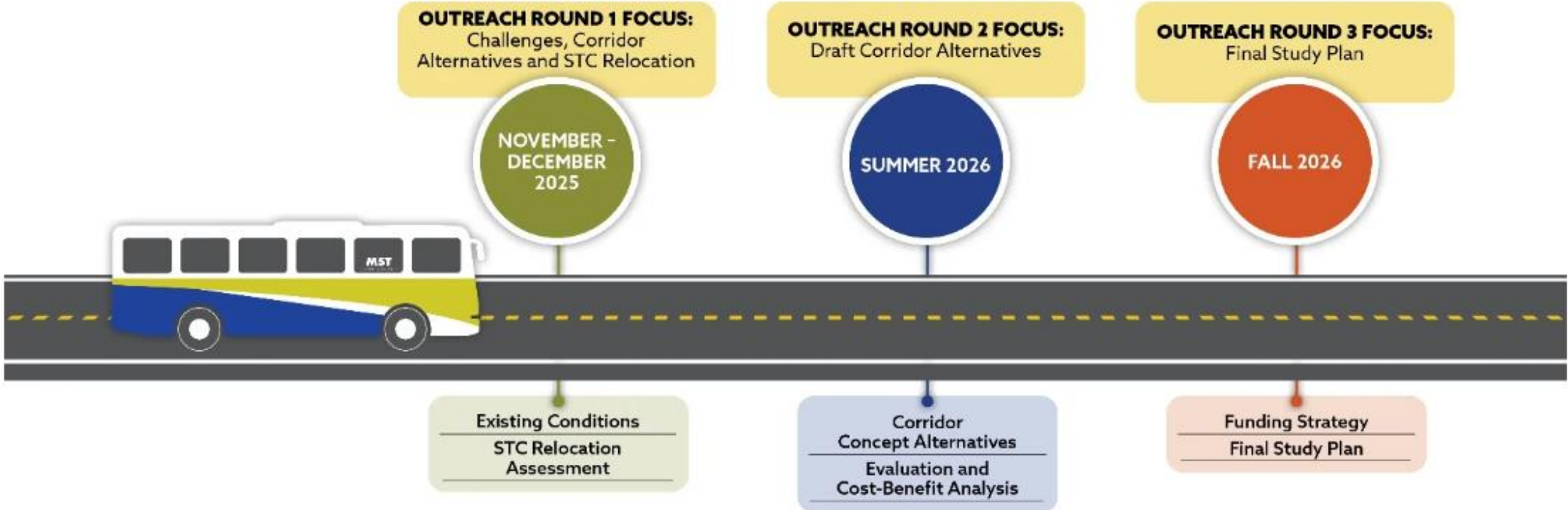

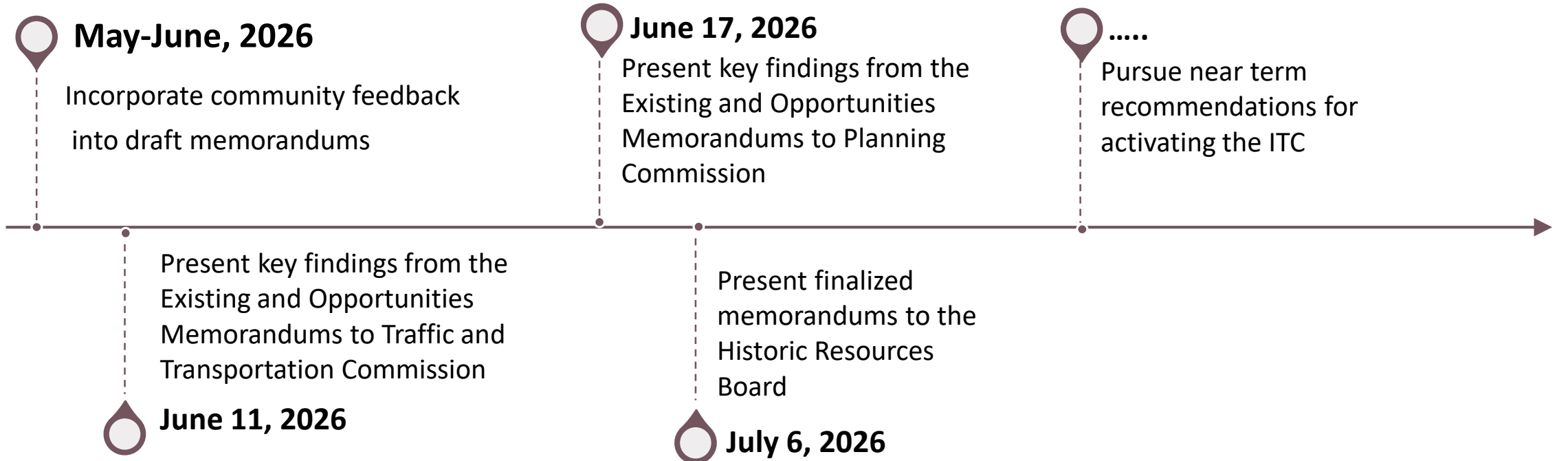
