A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE 2015 SPECIAL ASSESSMENT FOR COLLECTION OF UNPAID CHARGES FROM PROPERTY OWNERS

WHEREAS, notice of the time and place of said meeting has been given as required by the provisions of Municipal Code Section 1-49.2; and

WHEREAS, the Council hereby finds and determines that all protests and objections to said report and work done thereunder should be rejected and denied.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SALINAS:

- 1. That the "Special Assessment Charges for 2015" attached hereto as Exhibit A is hereby confirmed in full.
- 2. That, pursuant to Salinas Municipal Code Section 1-49.2, the amount of all charges and costs specified in Exhibit A, shall be entered upon assessment roll, to be collected at the same time and same manner as ordinary municipal taxes are collected, and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedure under foreclosure for sale and in case of delinquency as provided for in ordinary municipal taxes.
