A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TOTAL OF 90 FEET OF "NO STOPPING" RED ZONES AT THE INTERSECTION OF TOWT STREET AT SECOND AVENUE.

WHEREAS, staff received request to evaluate the intersection of Towt Street at Second Avenue for sight lines; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted an intersection sight distance analysis and is recommending a total of 90 feet of "No Stopping" red zones at the intersection of Towt Street and Second Avenue to provide sufficient intersection sight triangles; and

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2022, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted (4-0) to recommend to City Council the approval of establishing a total of 90 feet of "No Stopping" red zones at the intersection of Towt Street and Second Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the establishment of a total of 90 feet of "No Stopping" red zones at the intersection of Towt Street and Second Avenue.
