A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL AMENDING FUNDING PARAMETERS FOR THE ALLOCATION OF ESG PUBLIC SERVICES FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas participates in the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) program administered by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and such grant program allows for the City to allocate annual funding for the provision of needed "public services" to those homeless and/or at risk of becoming homeless within the community; and

WHEREAS, the Salinas City Council adopted a Consolidated Plan on June 1, 2010, covering fiscal years 2010 through 2015, that establishes priorities for the City's use of HUD funds; and

WHEREAS, the Salinas City Council requested the region's Continuum of Care to review funding allocation procedures for public services funds, including the establishment of written funding parameters; and

WHEREAS, the Salinas City Council adopted the ESG funding parameters on May 8, 2012 (Resolution No. 20189 N.C.S); and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Subcommittee of the City Council observed that the wording of ESG Funding Parameter No. 3 could benefit from clarification, namely the provision of "services in the community" could read "services to people in the City of Salinas," which also conforms to HUD regulations about beneficiaries of HUD-funded programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF SALINAS, that the attached ESG PUBLIC SERVICES FUNDING PARAMETERS – 2014, are hereby established as guidelines for the annual allocation of ESG funds for public services activities, thereby replacing the previous guidelines from 2012.
