**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE PROPOSED
MID-BLOCK CROSSWALK ON ROMIE LANE**

WHEREAS, the Salinas Valley Memorial Hospital proposed a new mid-block crosswalk on Romie Lane to improve crossing conditions for hospital staff; and

WHEREAS, the hospital recently redeveloped some of its buildings, which has created a crossing demand across Romie Lane directly in front of the Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the hospital hired a traffic engineer and prepared plans and specs to meet the City's crosswalk policy and standards; and

WHEREAS, the hospital is proposing installing a crosswalk, pedestrian refuge island and rectangular rapid flashing beacon system with an encroachment permit; and

WHEREAS, the crosswalk meets the City's crosswalk policy and city standards, therefore, staff recommends the approval of the proposed midblock crosswalk on Romie Lane; and

WHEREAS, at its June 11th, 2020 meeting, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted 6-0 to recommend to City Council approve a resolution approving a new mid-block crosswalk on Romie Lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby adopts a resolution approving a new mid-block crosswalk on Romie Lane; and
