A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE RELOCATION OF SCHOOL CROSSWALK AT SHERWOOD SCHOOL

WHEREAS, Staff received a request from a parent of disable student regarding challenges of using the crosswalk at its current location; and

WHEREAS, the reviewed the crosswalk location and confirmed potential accessibility challenges which can be improved by the relocation of the crosswalk; and

WHEREAS, the proposed relocation of the crosswalk will be completed with pedestrian access ramps compliant with ADA standards and improvements that support a safer path of travel; and

WHEREAS, at its June 11th, 2020 meeting, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted 7-0 to recommend to City Council to approve a resolution approving the relocation of the school crosswalk at Sherwood school.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approves the relocation of school crosswalk at Sherwood school and associated necessary parking restrictions in support of safe travel to school.
