## A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A LETTER OF AGREEMENT FOR THE TEMPORARY DIVERSION OF INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER FROM THE INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY TO M1W USING THE POND 3 PUMP STATION

**WHEREAS**, the ponds at the Industrial Wastewater Treatment Facility (IWTF) have reduced percolation and are coming close to the freeboard limits; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to maintain freeboard, the City requested M1W take water from pond 3 using the pond 3 pump station; and

**WHEREAS**, the City received a letter of agreement for temporary diversion of industrial wastewater from M1W on August 5, 2024; and

**WHEREAS**, the expected cost to M1W for accepting and treatment of the water from pond 3 is estimated to be between \$110,000 and \$200,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Salinas City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to sign the letter of agreement with W1W for the temporary diversion of industrial wastewater from the IWTF to M1W.
