Drug & Alcohol Interventions for Youth in Salinas

- Substance use intervention & gang education for youth & families
- Parent support group

Genesis House in Seaside

- Residential drug treatment for adults
- Perinatal program for pregnant & parenting women

Sonoma House in Seaside

- Transitional sober housing for single women

Elm House in Seaside

- Transitional sober housing for single men



Substance use Services, cont.

Off Main Clinic in Salinas

- Medication-assisted treatment & counseling for opioid dependent adults

Outpatient Treatment Centers in Salinas and Monterey

- Outpatient treatment for drug & alcohol addiction (youth & adults)



Substance Use Prevention Program (School-based)

- Counseling, Seven Challenges, Youth Alternatives to Violence Program (YATV), Alcohol & Drug Abuse Prevention Team (ADAPT), Vape Offense Workshops

Mental Health Services

Located at the Family Service Centers in Salinas and Seaside



Outpatient Mental Health Counseling

- Clinical therapy for depression, anxiety, relationships, family life, and more.
- Specialty programs for individuals impacted by HIV/AIDS and LGBTQ individuals.



Supervised Visitation Program

- Safe, supervised visits between non-custodial parents and their children.

Mental Health Services (continued)

Domestic Violence Intervention & Anger Management

- Psycho-educational group counseling for perpetrators of domestic violence.



Parenting Education Program

- Provides parenting classes & support to parents, many referred by Social Services.



Pathways to Safety

- Supportive services for families on the edge of the child welfare system.

Homeless Services



- **Safe Passage in Monterey**
 - Transitional supportive housing for youth 18-24
 - Case management
 - Life skills education
 - Information & referrals
 - Substance use & mental health referrals



- **Casa de Noche Buena in Seaside
Shuman HeartHouse in Monterey**
 - Low barrier shelter for single women & families with children
 - Case management
 - Housing navigation
 - Employment assistance
 - Information & referrals

Homeless Services, cont.

Safe Place in Monterey

- **Monterey Peninsula Street Outreach Program**
 - Street outreach to homeless youth 18-24
 - Case management; basic needs, I & R
 - Substance abuse education & intervention

Youth Shelter

- Emergency shelter for youth ages 18-24
- Case management, basic needs, I & R



Salinas Valley Street Outreach Program

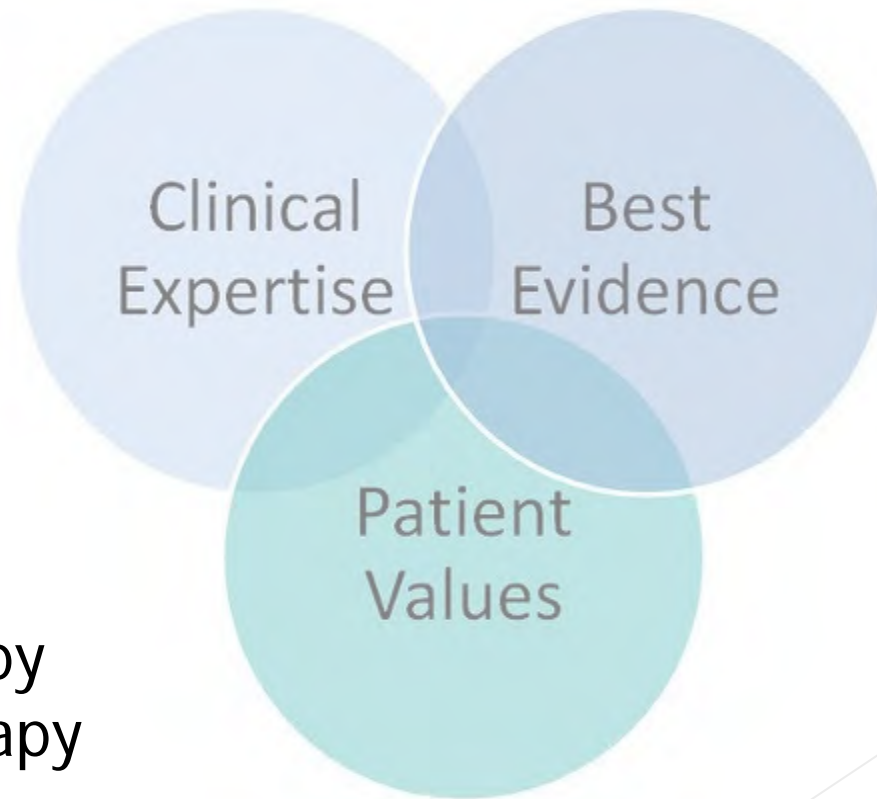
- Street outreach to homeless youth up to age 24
- Case management; distribution of clothing, food, water, hygiene & first aid products; I & R
- Substance abuse education & intervention
