

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING MASTER SERVICE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN THE CITY OF SALINAS AND MIG AND MODERN TIMES, INC FOR ON-CALL COMMUNITY EDUCATION AND OUTREACH SUPPORT RE: THE CITY’S “NO PARKING” STREET SWEEPING SIGNAGE PROGRAM AND DELEGATING AUTHORITY TO THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO THE AGREEMENTS

WHEREAS, on November 21, 2025, a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for providing on-call community education and outreach support for the City’s “No Parking” street sweeping signage program was advertised on “PlanetBids” website; and

WHEREAS, two submittals were received and reviewed based on the election criteria listed in the RFQ document; and

WHEREAS, Master Service Agreements were successfully secured with both firms; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the proposed action is not a project as defined by the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (CEQA Guidelines Section 15378);

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council approves the Master Service Agreements between the City of Salinas and MIG and Modern Times, Inc to provide on-call street sweeping education and outreach support from July 1, 2026 to July 1, 2031 in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 over the 5-year term, or \$200,000 annually per consultant, subject to appropriation of funds; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the City of Salinas, and its act and deed, to execute the attached Master Service Agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager is authorized to execute extensions and/or modifications to the Agreements and to take whatever additional action may be necessary to effectuate the intent of this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Public Works Director or their designee is hereby authorized to approve the Consultant’s on-going performance of services without the need for subsequent Service Agreements provided the Consultant is, at all times throughout the term thereof, in compliance with the terms and conditions of the Master Service Agreement approved through this Resolution.
