A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE 2023-2024 SPECIAL CURB MARKINGS LIST AND THE REMOVAL OF FIVE (5) SPECIAL CURB MARKING PARKING STALLS AT 534, 536 AND 546 ABBOTT STREET

WHEREAS, the City’s Special Curb Marking Program is a resource available for businesses and property owners to establish on-street parking regulations along their property frontage; and

WHEREAS, the program is cost neutral to the City and the applicant is generally responsible for the costs of installing and maintaining their special curb markings; and

WHEREAS, a representative from A & O S Specialty Pharmacy requested to opt out of the Special Curb Marking Program, and payment was received to renew and refresh all other special curb markings; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting of July 13, 2023, the Salinas Traffic and Transportation Commission voted (4-0) to recommended to City Council to approve a resolution to update the status of the 2023-2024 special curb markings and delete special curb markings where businesses have requested the removal of existing special curb markings or did not submit the annual renewal fee to retain markings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council approve a resolution approving the 2023-2024 special curb markings list and the removal of five (5) special curb marking parking stalls at 534, 536 and 546 Abbott Street.
