A RESOLUTION OF THE SALINAS CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISHING 45 FEET OF “NO STOPPING” RED ZONES AT THE INTERSECTION OF HUMBOLDT DRIVE AND DONNER WAY

WHEREAS, the City received a request to evaluate corner sight distance at the intersections of Humboldt Drive and Donner Way and along Pescadero Drive to determine proper sightlines necessary to provide stopping sight distance; and

WHEREAS, staff conducted an intersection sight distance analysis and is recommending the establishment of 45 feet of “No Stopping” red zones at the intersection of Humboldt Drive and Donner Way; and

WHEREAS, on July 13, 2023, the Traffic and Transportation Commission meeting, the Traffic and Transportation Commission voted (4-1) to recommend to the City Council the approval of a Resolution establishing a total of 45 feet of “No Stopping” red zones at the intersection of Humboldt Drive and Donner Way; and

WHEREAS, the City of Salinas has determined that the implementing the parking restrictions is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines (Section 15301, Class 1). The project consists of the operation, repair, or minor alteration of public streets involving no expansion of use. There would be no significant effect on the environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Salinas City Council hereby approved the establishment of 45 feet of “No Stopping” red zones at the intersection of Humboldt Drive and Donner Way.
